"Several options are available to us in addressing problem veins," adds N. John Collucci, DO, Dr. Stein's partner. "Our goal is to

provide the most efficient and compassionate care to our patients."

The doctors agree that vein stripping, in most instances, is an outdated procedure. In its place they use endovascular laser treatment for closure of varicose veins in addition to microphlebectomy and ultrasound-guided sclerotherapy. The doctors also encourage patients not to accept imitations of this technology.

"In contrast to many centers, where partial treatments are performed, we treat the entire vein problem — from spider veins to serious venous disease," says Dr. Stein. "Most procedures are covered by Medicare, and many insurance companies reimburse for them."

Drs. Collucci and Stein emphasize the importance of patients being treated by qualified physicians to avoid potential complications.

"Dr. Stein and I are both medical physicians and members of the American College of Phlebology,"

Dr. Collucci explains, "and have extensive experience with these treatments."
