

Spinal Decompression Works

Patients treated with DRX9000 won't require surgery in most cases, adds Dr. Abendroth.

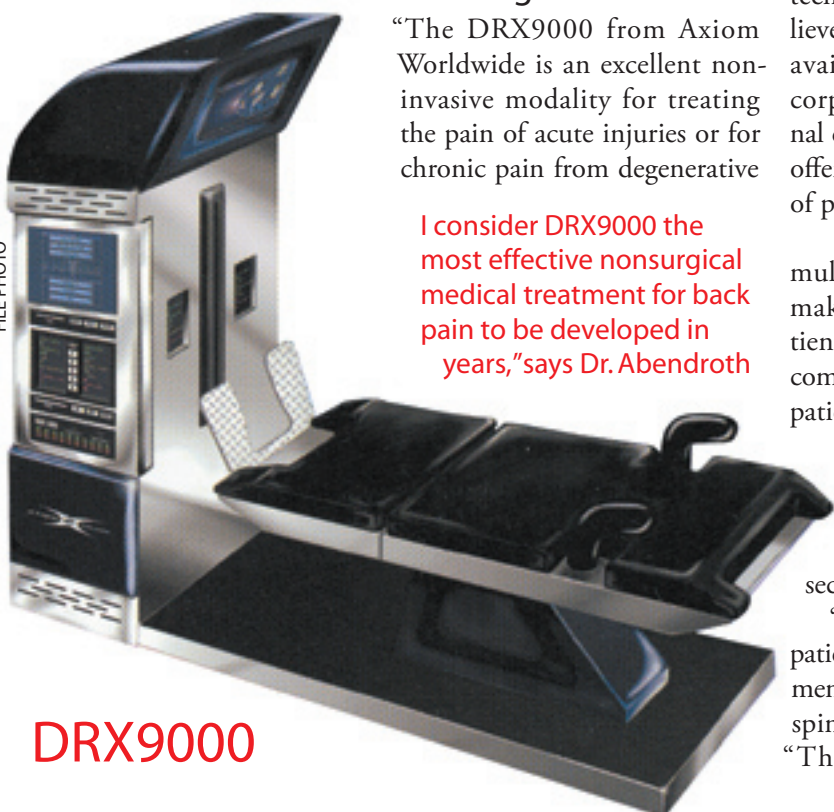
